Time commitment: 10 hours per week

Responsibilities:

- With the Cricket Committee, select teams for all senior matches on a weekly basis, ensuring that the Selection Policy is followed.
- Work with the Coaches etc to ensure players and teams are developed to realise their full potential. Help the Coach with training and auxiliary team duties.
- Maintain harmonious relations with league captains and discipline on the field of play.
- Communicate clearly and regularly with players regarding expectations, performances, strategies for improvement. Ensure players' conduct and behaviour is respectful and meets the club's expectations.
- Encourage club members to be involved in social and voluntary activities.
- Pre-match and post-match administration such as collecting match fees and filing scores.
- Support player and volunteer recruitment efforts.
